- Four-season **Resort** on 350 acres, with natural breathtaking views of the sparkling lake; offering endless activities for couples, families, skiers, snowshoers, equestrian and adventure enthusiasts.
- **Equestrian Center** with 30 or more horses; instruction in English, Western, Dressage and Cross-Country Jumping for riders of all skill levels; guided trail rides on miles of scenic trails with views of the lake and the mountains.
- Just eleven miles from Killington, the **Resort** features its own renowned **Nordic Ski & Snowshoe Center** with 60km of trails (40km groomed), classic, skating lanes and pristine backcountry on hundreds of acres, with elevations up to 2,175 feet. Varied terrain for all skill levels. The Center is managed by a friendly, experienced and skilled staff offering private or group lessons for all ages and levels. The Nordic Ski & Snowshoe Center has equipment rentals and café. Designated trails (10km) are pet friendly. State-of-the-art grooming and snowmaking capabilities ensure the best conditions in the area.

 - swimming (outdoor pool or private sandy-beach)
 - kayaks, canoes, complimentary to be used on the 741-acre lake
 - pontoon boat for scenic cruises
 - fly fishing (offsite)
 - tennis court
 - hiking, mountain biking
 - lawn games: croquet, shuffleboard, badminton, sand volleyball
 - clay bird shooting range with instruction and equipment
 - ice skating and sledding hill in winter
 - magical winter sleigh rides drawn by a team of Percherons or Clydesdales
 - snowmobile tours
 - dog sledding

- Private chalet rentals also available to accommodate up to 18 guests.
- Casual yet refined décor in the tradition of the *classic mountain lodges*.
- Accommodations feature sweeping views of the mountains and lake and have one king or two queen beds; one room with balcony and two with kitchenette, whirlpool bath, and television. All rooms have cable television. Rustic mountain cabins, some with wood burning fireplaces, are pet friendly. Private chalets vary in size from two to six bedrooms; have full kitchens with dining area, living room, TV/VCR, fireplace, and additional amenities.
